Charity

The Charity Lotto has been hugely successful in raising funds for charity, with a £10 donation and Gift Aid making each donation worth £11.25, with a monthly prize draw of £500. The Trustees would like to thank our Lotto Member legal practices who collectively have raised £966,038.23 since 2014 with over £66,000 distributed in prize money.
